As we reflect on another year of significant progress, I would like to express my gratitude to you all for your continued hard work and dedication. This year, AMR was in the global spotlight, with significant milestones achieved at the G7 and UN General Assembly.

The political declaration committing to reduce AMR-related deaths by 10% by 2030 is a testament to the collective efforts within the AMR community.

REVERSE has made substantial progress. Our successful Annual Project Meeting in Barcelona, the timely submission of the second technical report, the first PPS of rectal swabs, the ICP and ABS workshops, and the completion of the site visits are notable achievements. **The scientific community has taken notice, with our work featured at prestigious international events** including ESCMID Global, SEIMC, SIRC, IMPACT, and the UMFCO National Conference.

Looking ahead to 2025, we anticipate further achievements. Multiple abstracts have been submitted to ESCMID Global in Vienna, and several publications are in the pipeline. The launch of the Online Serious Game – Fight the Resistance – will engage a wider audience to promote Infection prevention and control.

I encourage you to mark your calendars for the fourth Annual Project Meeting in Vienna on April 11th. As Jan aptly stated in his July interview, collaboration is key! **Indeed, collaboration has been excellent within REVERSE, and I would like to thank you all for this!** Together, we drive our project forward and make a lasting impact on global health.

- IPC and ABS implementation workshops complete for all cohorts



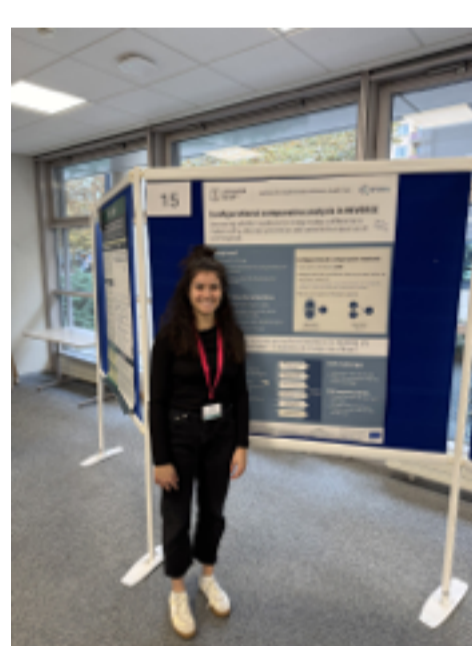
