EU Innovation Radar



The Innovation Radar is a European Commission initiative to identify high potential innovations and innovators in EU-funded research and innovation projects. At the end of 2024, three REVERSE initiatives were officially recognised as Exploring Innovations, identifying them as key innovations using novel technologies, with the future potential to be a game-changer for industry.

1. Multi language online serious game for improving knowledge about MDRs and IPC.
2. Online antimicrobial stewardship assessment platform for hospitals to guide antimicrobial stewardship initiatives.
3. Novel health economic models for assessing the cost effectiveness of healthcare practise changes.

The Commission also highlighted that two innovations were women-led - meaning a woman had a leadership role in the development of the innovation at the key innovator organisation.
